1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The Summer Series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1, shall apply for dinghy's and open boats.
- 1.3 Class safety rules shall apply for all Platu 25 yachts
- 1.4 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part II, Category 5 shall apply for all other keelboats.
- 1.5 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part V, Category C shall apply to trailer yachts.
- 1.6 The YNZ Sport Boat Regulations Part VI Category B shall apply for all sport boats.
- 1.7 A boat shall not discharge rubbish in the water.

2.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The series is open to all classes.
- 2.2 To enter, complete the attached entry form accompanied by the relevant fee and email, fax or post it to The Sailing Administrator, or use The RAYC post box in the Clubhouse foyer.
- 2.3 Individual Race entries should be made on the Friday before that race, except that a boat that is not previously entered may do so by informing the Race Officer and starting the race. By starting a boat acknowledges that an entry fee is payable. If no entry fee is paid before or on the day of racing no results will be published for that boat and the boat will be ineligible for prizes from that Race Day. Individual race entrants are ineligible for points towards the series.
- 2.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

The scheduled time of the first warning signal for the first division in will be 1255 hours.

Divisions will usually start in the order listed in NOR 3.3 but this may be altered at the Race officer's discretion for any race. Divisions may be combined.

- 3.2 The first warning signal for any sequence of starts shall not be made after 1630 hours.

3.4 Divisions may be added and/ or adjusted depending on entries received.

4.0 Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available from Friday 24 September, 2010 on the RAYC website (www.rayc.org.nz) and the RAYC race office on weekdays between 0900 & 1600 hrs.

5.0 Racing Area

All Courses: the races will be held in the area bounded by Mechanics Bay, Rangitoto Island, Browns Island and St Heliers.

6.0 Courses to be Sailed

The Laid courses will be Windward/ Leewards and/or Triangle courses.
The Harbour courses will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

7.0 Scoring

7.1 Four (4) races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.

7.2 (a) When six or fewer races have been completed: a boats series score will be the total of all her races.

(b) When seven to ten races have been completed: a boats series score will be the total of all her races excluding her two worst scores.

When more than eleven races have been completed: a boats series score will be the total of all her races excluding her three worst scores.

7.3 Rule A9 shall apply

8.0 Alternative Penalties

8.1 For the all classes rule 44.2 is changed so that the 720° turn is replaced by a 360° turn.

9.0 Prizes

9.1 Weekly Prize Giving's will be held at RAYC as soon as possible after racing

9.2 The Series Prize Giving will be held in conjunction with the RAYC Club Prize Giving. Prizes will be as detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

10.0 Disclaimer of liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
