2	Start to Waiheke Island (P), Gannet Rock (P), Rakino, Motutapu and Rangitoto Islands (P), to finish.	55nm
3	Start to Rangitoto and Motutapu Islands (S), Browns Island Navy Buoy (P), Passage Rock (S), to finish.	44nm
4	Start to Whangaparoa outermost yellow buoy (S), Haystack / Orarapa Island (S), to finish.	33nm
