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Notice of Race

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part I shall apply.
- 1.3 Flying Fifteen Class Association Rules will apply.

2.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Fifteen class that comply with class rules.
- 2.2 Advance entries will be accepted until the closing date of Friday 11th February 1600hrs, by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$100 and mailing it to The Sailing Administrator, Royal Akarana Yacht Club, or by using the RAYC post box in the Club house foyer.
- 2.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant's national authority.
- 2.4 Each entrant shall be a financial member of the Flying Fifteen National Association.

3.0 Schedule of Events

Racing Schedule:

- 3.1 The Flying Fifteen Auckland Championships will be held in conjunction with the Farr 727 and F18 Nationals.
- 3.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the Flying Fifteen Class for Race 1 is 1000 hours on Saturday, 12 February
- 3.3 Up to 9 races are scheduled.

4.0 Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available by Thursday, 10th February from the RAYC Race Office, 0900 – 1600 Monday to Friday and on the RAYC website www.rayc.org.nz.

5.0 Racing Area

The races will be held in the area bounded by Mechanics Bay, Bean Rock, Rangitoto Island, Browns Island and St Heliers.

6.0 Courses to be Sailed

The course (s) will be windward/ leewards or triangles.

7.0 Scoring

- 7.1 The Low Points scoring system of Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 Five races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.3 Appendix A4.2 is modified to read:

A boat that did not *start*, retired after *finishing* or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the series. A boat that did not *finish* shall be scored points for the finishing place two more than the number of boats who finished the race without subsequently retiring or being disqualified. A boat penalised under rule 30.2 or 44.3 shall be scored points as provided in rule 44.3 (c).

8.0 Prizes

The following prizes shall be awarded at the Official Prize giving to be held as soon as practicable after racing on Sunday, 13th February

First place on line shall be awarded the Flying Fifteen Auckland Championship Cup.
Other prizes to be awarded will be as detailed in Sailing Instructions.

9.0 Team Support Boats

Team support boats will be allowed.
